



Jim has made a hobby of collecting vintage gas station pumps and memorabilia. In 2003 he built a new station to hold the artifacts.

Located in the heart of downtown Coalburg, Ohio, the Coalburg Garage sits on the Northwest corner of Chestnut Ridge and Wick Campbell Roads and is a tribute to days gone by. The pumps out front are a pair of Wayne 60s, from the early 1930s and are clearly branded with the Pennzoil name.

The original Coalburg gas station, located 300 yards to the South was owned by Paul Campbell. Many of his original items can be found in Jim's Coalburg Garage, including his shop coat, work boots, service certificates as well as porcelain Pennzoil signs.

The Coalburg Garage has been publicized in newspapers, magazines as well as on television and has numerous car clubs having their car cruises and tours at this historic location.

As you drive through Hubbard you will see other restored gas pumps scattered among the many commercial properties Jim has renovated. Also check out the pumps at his office and behind the Emerald Diner.
